

ORDINANCE NO. 81-1

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A PERMIT FOR INSTALLATION OF  
TELEVISION CABLE WITHIN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF  
LAKE SHORE DRIVE IN LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, it has been reported to this Board that the City of Michigan City, Indiana, on the 17th day of July, 1980, entered into a contract with COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC., awarding said corporation a non-exclusive franchise to operate a cable communication system in said City; and

WHEREAS, it has been further reported to this Board that the Board of Directors of Duneland Beach Association, Inc., on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of NOVEMBER, 1980, adopted a Resolution authorizing the extension of said system into Duneland Beach for a period ending July 17, 1995; and

WHEREAS, COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC., and the Board of Directors of Duneland Beach Association, Inc., have petitioned this Board to grant a permit to COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC., to install television cable within the right-of-way of Lake Shore Drive in Duneland Beach; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed by this Board to be in the best interests of the citizens of LaPorte County to grant said petition.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC., is hereby granted a permit to install its television cable within the right-of-way of Lake Shore Drive between the east boundary of the Town of Long Beach, Indiana, and the west boundary of the Town of Michiana Shores, Indiana, provided that in so doing, COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC., shall obtain any necessary pole use permits from the utilities currently maintaining facilities within said right-of-way.

SECTION 2. That this permit shall be granted for the period commencing upon the effective date of this ordinance and ending July 17, 1995.

SECTION 3. This permit shall automatically be extended to coincide with the period of any extension of the operation of said cable communication system in Duneland Beach after July 17, 1995.

SECTION 4. Whereas, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect after its passage and signature by the Board of County Commissioners, LaPorte County, Indiana.

A M E N D M E N T S

A. Add the following clauses to Section 1:

.... and provided further that in so doing COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC. shall use aerial facilities only and shall obtain any other necessary county permits.

B. Add the following sentence to Section 2:

COX CABLE OF MICHIGAN CITY, INC. shall file a satisfactory certificate of public liability insurance with the Building Commissioner and shall maintain the same in full force and effect throughout the effective period of this permit.
