

ORDINANCE OF LAPORTE COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

NO. 84-6

WHEREAS, the residents of Coolspring Township, LaPorte County, Indiana, have petitioned the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners to establish a speed limit of 20 miles per hour on Wozniak Road, from 450N to Johnson Road, in Coolspring Township; and

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners have the authority under Indiana Code 9-4-2-58 to establish the rate of speed on designated county roadways; and,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:


1. That pursuant to Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to exceed 20 miles per hour on Wozniak Road, from 450N to Johnson Road;

2. That the LaPorte County Highway Department is hereby directed and ordered to post Wozniak Road, from 450N to Johnson Road with signs indicating 20 miles per hour;

3. That after the roadway has been posted in accordance with paragraph 2, herein it shall be a misdemeanor under Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 for any person to violate this Ordinance.


