

ORDINANCE OF LAPORTE COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
NO. 85-3


WHEREAS, The residents of Scipio Township, LaPorte County, Indiana, have petitioned the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners to establish a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on Joliet Road, between 400 W. and Long Lane in Scipio Township; and

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners have the authority under Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 to establish the rate of speed on designated county roadways; and,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:

1. That pursuant to Indiana code 9-4-1-58 it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to exceed 30 miles per hour on Joliet Road, between 400 W. and Long Lane, in Scipio Township;
2. That the LaPorte County Highway Department is hereby directed and ordered to post Joliet Road, between 400 W. and Long Lane with signs indicating 30 miles per hour;
3. That after the roadway has been posted in accordance with Paragraph 2, herein it shall be a misdemeanor under Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 for any person to violate this Ordinance.


