

AN ORDINANCE CREATING NEW COUNTY  
COUNCIL DISTRICTS IN THE COUNTY  
OF LA PORTE, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the La Porte County Board of Commissioners has the authority to divide the County into four (4) contiguous, single member county council districts under provisions of I.C. 36-2-3-4,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of La Porte County, Indiana that the following territory within said County is divided into county councilman districts, defined, to-wit:

DISTRICT 1:

The townships of Cass, Dewey, Prairie, Hanna, Scipio (outside La Porte), Center (North, South, Pine), Noble, New Durham, Clinton, the Fifth Ward of the City of La Porte and the Second Ward of the City of La Porte.

DISTRICT 2:

The townships of Coolspring (outside Michigan City), Michigan: First Precinct, Springfield, the Fourth Ward of Michigan City and the Sixth Ward of Michigan City.

DISTRICT 3:

Second Precinct of Michigan Township, Long Beach, the First Ward of Michigan City, Second Ward of Michigan City, Third Ward of Michigan City and the Fifth Ward of Michigan City.

DISTRICT 4:

The townships of Union, Johnson, Lincoln, Pleasant, Wills, Kankakee (outside La Porte), Hudson, Galien, Washington, the First Ward of the City of La Porte, the Fourth Ward of the City of La Porte, and the Third Ward of the City of La Porte.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:


1. All other ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

and remain in effect.


3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon approval by the Board of Commissioners of La Porte County.




