

ORDINANCE OF LAPORTE COUNTY


WHEREAS, The residents of Center Township, LaPorte County, Indiana have petitioned the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners to establish a speed limit of 20 miles per hour be posted at Farmwood Drive and Sunrise Drive in the subdivision of Decker Woods, in Center Township; and

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners have the authority under Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 to establish the rate of speed on designated county roadways; and,


IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:

1. That pursuant to Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to exceed 20 miles per hour in the subdivision of Decker Woods, in Center Township; and
2. That the LaPorte County Highway Department is hereby directed and ordered to post Farmwood Drive and Sunrise Drive in the subdivision of Decker Woods with signs indicating 20 miles per hour;
3. That after the roadway has been posted in accordance with paragraph 2, herein it shall be a misdemeanor under Indiana Code 9-4-1-58 for any person to violate this Ordinance.


