

ORDINANCE OF THE  
LA PORTE COUNTY BOARD  
OF COMMISSIONERS

NO. 86-10

WHEREAS, the office of County Treasurer is required under the provisions of I.C. 6-1.1-22-8 to mail a statement containing current and delinquent taxes and special assessments to each property taxpayer once each year, and

WHEREAS, the annual statement contains on it the dates on which the first and second installments are due, denotes the amount of money to be paid for each installment, and gives notice in large print that no separate statement will be sent in advance of the due date of the second installment, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of this Board that a number of taxpayers lose or misplace their annual statement thereby requiring the Office of Treasurer to print a new tax bill when the taxpayer proceeds to pay an installment, and

WHEREAS, the printing of a new tax bill requires time and expense for the Office of Treasurer which must search out the information and mechanically reproduce a tax bill, and

WHEREAS, this Board believes it only fair that the responsible taxpayer bear the cost of this additional service,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board as follows:

Section 1. In the event that a taxpayer has misplaced his or her statement of current taxes, delinquent taxes, and special assessments and then attempts payment of taxes due and owing without such statement thereby necessitating the printing of a new statement, the Office of Treasurer is authorized to collect a service reproduction fee of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per statement printed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect

from and after its passage, approval and publication.
