AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE SOUTHERLY TEN FEET (10') OF DIVISION STREET IN ROLLING PRAIRIE, INDIANA, LOCATED BETWEEN THE WESTERLY LINE OF OAK STREET (THAT ALSO BEING THE NORTH-EASTERLY POINT OF LOT TWELVE (12) OF W. J. WALKER'S ADDITION), AND THE WESTERLY SIDE OF LOT TEN (10) OF W. J. WALKER'S ADDITION, ROLLING PRAIRIE, LA PORTE COUNTY, INDIANA Plat Book #1 Page 108

NOW THEREFORE,






be, and the same is, hereby vacated as a public way.

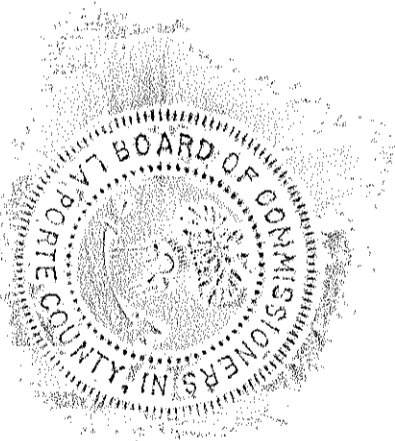
