ORDINANCE OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

NO. 86-14

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF
A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 700 EAST TO
"COUGAR ROAD"

WHEREAS the Administration and student body of New Prairie High School, in order to reflect pride in that institution, to enhance the already strong sense of "school spirit", and to facilitate location of the campus for those unfamiliar with the area, have requested a new designation for that section of the county road on which the school is situated; and

WHEREAS Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 stipulates that "The Board of County Commissioners...is...authorized and empowered to locate, establish,...(and) change...all public highways...in the county..."; and

WHEREAS no objection to this change is voiced by the county police department, highway department, or surveyor;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, that the section of County Road 700 East bordered by U.S. Highway 20 on the north and State Road 2 on the south be renamed "COUGAR ROAD"; and that this new designation be noted on county maps and through signage where appropriate.
