

AN ORDINANCE CREATING NEW COUNTY  
COMMISSION DISTRICTS IN THE COUNTY  
OF LA PORTE, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the La Porte County Board of Commissioners has the authority to divide the County in three (3) county commission districts under the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of La Porte County, Indiana that the following territory within said County is divided into county commission districts, defined, to-wit:

DISTRICT 1:

All of Coolspring Township and Michigan Township (except those portions included in District 3) shall constitute the limits of the First Commissioner District.

DISTRICT 2:

The townships of Hudson, Johnson, Lincoln, Pleasant, Union, Washington and Wills; and those parts of the City of La Porte included in Center, Kankakee and Scipio Townships shall constitute the limits of the Second Commissioner District.

DISTRICT 3:

The townships of Cass, Clinton, Dewey, Galena, Hanna, New Durham, Noble, Prairie and Springfield; the townships of Center, Kankakee and Scipio out-side the City of La Porte; and the following portions of Michigan Township: Long Beach (Precincts 1 and 2); Michigan Township Precinct 1 (Trail Creek); Michigan Township Precinct 2; Michigan City Ward 6, Precinct 1; Michigan City Ward 6, Precinct 2; shall constitute the limits of the Third Commissioner District.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

1. All other ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
2. Should any provision of this ordinance be held invalid, all


other provisions contained herein shall be considered valid and remain in effect.

3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval and publication by the Board of Commissioners of La Porte County.

4. Commissioners elected at the general election of 1986 for full 4-year terms shall continue to hold office as residents of the new districts in which their legal residence is located until the terms for which they were elected have expired.
