

ORDINANCE OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
NO. 88-7

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County is responsible for formulating County Road policy consistent with the Statutes of the State of Indiana; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County recognize that a hazardous situation exists and have decided, therefore, that it is necessary to install STOP signs on C.R. 450 N. in Center Twp; and,


WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County have the authority under Indiana Code 9-4-2-1-110, Sec. 1, in accordance with the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:

1. That pursuant to Indiana Code 9-4-2-1-110, Sec. 1, it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to disregard said Traffic Control Devices on C. R. 450 N. where C.R. 450 N. intersects C.R. 325 W. Center, Twp.
2. That the LaPorte County Highway Department is hereby directed and ordered to install said Traffic Control Devices.
 - A.-C.R. 450 N. - Stop sign installed on the South-West side for East bound traffic where 450 N. intersects C.R. 325 W. Center Twp.
 - B.-C.R. 450 N. - Stop sign installed on the North-East corner for West bound traffic where 450 N. intersects C.R. 325 W., Center Twp.
3. That after the intersection has been posted in accordance with paragraph 2, herein, it shall be a misdemeanor under Indiana Code 9-4-2-1-127, Sec. 1, for any person to violate this ordinance.


