

ORDINANCE NO. 88-11, 1988

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF LAPORTE
CONSENTING TO THE TRANSFER OF A
FRANCHISE OF CABLE TELEVISION

WHEREAS, on October 24, 1983, the County Commissioners of LaPorte County passed Ordinance No. 83-8 granting a franchise to Lakeshore Communications, a joint venture, for the construction and operation of a CATV system in the County of LaPorte, Indiana, which franchise they still hold; and,

WHEREAS, Lakeshore Communications, a joint venture, now desires to sell, assign, and transfer said franchise, as well as other assets of the company, to Prime Cable Income Partners L.P., a Delaware limited partnership; and,

WHEREAS, the ordinances referred to above provide for the approval and consent of the County Commissioners prior to any transfer, exchange or sale of said franchise and assets to Prime Cable Income Partners L.P.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Commissioners of the County of LaPorte, Indiana, as follows:

1. That the County Commissioners of the County of LaPorte, Indiana, hereby consents to the sale, transfer and assignment by Lakeshore Communications, a joint venture, of its existing franchises pursuant to Ordinance No. 83-8, as amended, together with the assets located in the County of LaPorte, Indiana, to Prime Cable Income Partners L.P., a Delaware limited partnership (hereinafter referred to as "Prime").

2. That Prime shall have all the rights and privileges given to Lakeshore Communications, a joint venture, under said Ordinance 83-8 and any amendments thereto, and shall in the future be responsible for the same obligations as Lakeshore Communications, a joint venture, including all franchise payments to the County of LaPorte, Indiana, which occur after the passage of this ordinance.

3. That the prior consent and approval of the County Commissioners of the County of LaPorte shall be required for any future transfer, exchange or sale of assets or stock or other equity control of Prime to the extent provided for in Ordinance 83-8 and any amendments thereto.

4. Prime may use its franchise or the CATV System for the County of LaPorte, its stock or other equity control and assets as collateral for any financing for the CATV System within LaPorte County, Indiana, which it may deem necessary without approval of the County Commissioners.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect immediately upon

its passage and adoption by the County Commissioners of the County of LaPorte.
