

ORDINANCE NO. 90-1

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A COUNTY-WIDE FEE  
AND ESTABLISHING A COUNTY-WIDE ENHANCED  
EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-8-16-5(a) allows for the establishment by the county fiscal body of a county-wide enhanced emergency telephone system and the imposition of a fee to pay the costs of said system and

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Council has determined after due deliberation and consideration that the establishment of an enhanced emergency telephone system within LaPorte County will benefit the citizens of LaPorte County and help protect the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of LaPorte County.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby ordained by the LaPorte County Council:

Section 1: The LaPorte Council does hereby establish and impose an enhanced emergency telephone system fee at the rate of 0.66 (0.66), per month. Said fee to be assessed on each exchange access facility in the service area covered by the enhanced emergency system.

Section 2: The enhanced emergency telephone system funded by the fee established under this ordinance shall consist of one (1) primary public safety answering point to be located at the LaPorte County Sheriff's Department.

Section 3: The provisions of I.C. 36-8-16-1 through 19 shall control the operation of the enhanced emergency telephone system and the imposition and collection of the system fee.

Section 4: Pursuant to I.C. 36-8-16-9, the fee established by this ordinance shall take effect on the first day of JAN., 1991.
