

AN ORDINANCE TO RENAME CERTAIN STREETS  
IN THE COMMUNITY OF FISH LAKE,  
LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana is charged with the responsibility of maintenance, supervision and organization of the streets and roads in the rural and unincorporated areas of LaPorte County, and;

WHEREAS, the responsibility of the Commissioners is to see that said streets and roads are designated by names or numbers, and;

WHEREAS, said road and street designations should be clear, orderly, and non-repetitive where possible, and;

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that certain street names in and about the vicinity of the community of Fish Lake are confusingly similar or repetitive leading to confusion in the delivery of mail or delivery of emergency services in the community, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commissioners to rename certain streets in order to remove the confusion.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners as follows:

Streets in the vicinity of Fish Lake shall be renamed as follows:

1. A segment of the street currently known as Lakeview Drive that intersects with Hillside Drive shall be renamed Lincoln Drive the entire length.
2. A segment of the street currently known as Lakeview Drive intersecting with Glenwood Drive and running to Holly Drive shall be renamed Glenwood Drive the entire length.
3. A segment of the street currently known as Lakeshore Drive that intersects with N. Longshore Drive at Hillcrest Drive and runs northeast shall be renamed N. Longshore the entire length.
4. A segment of the street currently known as Lakeshore Drive that intersects with Glenwood Drive and runs into the subdivision known as Smith's Grove, along with Oak Drive, Community Road and Shady Lane, all in the Smith's Grove subdivision, shall be renamed Shady Lane for the entire length.
5. The street known as Longshore Drive shall be split at the intersection with State Road 4 and renamed and renumbered as North Longshore and South Longshore in the proper directions the entire lengths.

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Highway Department is instructed to erect street signs with the new name designations on the streets following

the passage of this ordinance.

WHEREAS, notice of the change in name shall be directed to the United States Postal Service, the Lincoln Township Fire Department, LaPorte County Emergency Medical Services and LaPorte County Sheriff's Department.

All of which is ordained and passed this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 1991, by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County.
