ORDINANCE NO. 92-3 24-18-08-259-010

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF AN ALLEY THAT  
ABUTS LOTS 1, 2, 3 AND 11, IN YOUNG'S ADDITION  
TO THE TOWN OF HANNA, HANNA TOWNSHIP  
LA PORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Joel Doms and Darla Doms, of Hanna, La Porte County, Indiana, have filed a petition, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-3-12, with the Board of County Commissioners of La Porte County, Indiana, asking that a portion of a certain alley, located in the Town of Hanna, Hanna Township, and being more particularly described as follows, be vacated, to-wit:

A portion of an alley located in Block 4 of Young's Addition, bordering parts of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 11, as shown in the plat of this addition as recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 182, of the records in the Recorder's office of La Porte County, Indiana, which portion of the alley to be vacated is more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 1; thence southeasterly along the westerly line of Ohio Street, a distance of 12.00 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 11; thence westerly along the north line of Lot 11, a distance of 99.00 feet; thence northeasterly, a distance of 12.00 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 3; thence easterly along the south line of Lots 3, 2 and 1, a distance of 99.00 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning,  
and,

WHEREAS, following the filing of this petition the Board of County Commissioners scheduled a public hearing thereon to be held on this date; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of La Porte County, Indiana, did give notice of the filing of this petition and of the hearing thereon by publication in the manner prescribed by I.C. 5-3-1-1 et seq; and,

WHEREAS, there were no other persons who owned property that abutted the portion of this alley who needed to be given notice of the filing of this petition; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the legislative body of La Porte County, Indiana, has now conducted the public hearing on the petition to vacate and has determined that the alley described above should be vacated, all as permitted by I.C. 36-7-3-12;



Section 1. BE IT, AND IT IS, HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of La Porte County, Indiana, that the following described real estate situated in La Porte County, State of Indiana, to-wit:

A portion of an alley located in Block 4 of Young's Addition, bordering parts of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 11, as shown in the plat of this addition as recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 182, of the records in the Recorder's office of La Porte County, Indiana, which portion of the alley to be vacated is more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 1; thence southeasterly along the westerly line of Ohio Street, a distance of 12.00 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 11; thence westerly along the north line of Lot 11, a distance of 99.00 feet; thence northeasterly, a distance of 12.00 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 3; thence easterly along the south line of Lots 3, 2 and 1, a distance of 99.00 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, be, and the same is, hereby vacated as a public way.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of La Porte County, Indiana, shall furnish a copy of this vacation ordinance to the La Porte County Recorder in order that the same may be placed of record in the records of the Recorder's Office, and shall also furnish a copy to the La Porte County Auditor.
