

ORDINANCE OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
NO. 92-6

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County is responsible for formulating County Road policy consistent with the Statutes of the State of Indiana; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County recognize that a hazardous situation exists and have decided, therefore, that it is necessary to install STOP signs on C.R. 50 W. at its intersection with C.R. 400 N. in Center Twp.; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County have the authority under Indiana Code 9-4-2-1-110, Sec. 1, in accordance with the Indiana Manual on Uniform Traffic Control devices for Streets and Highways;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED:

1. That pursuant to Indiana Code 9-4-2-1-110, Sec. 1, it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to disregard said Traffic Control Devices on C.R. 50 W. where C.R. 50 W. intersects with C.R. 400 N. in Center Twp.
2. That the LaPorte County Highway Department is hereby directed and ordered to install said Traffic Control Devices.
  - A. C.R. 50 W. -- STOP signs installed for North bound and South bound traffic where C.R. 50 W. intersects with C.R. 400 N. in Center Twp.
3. That after the intersection has been posted in accordance with paragraph 2, herein, it shall be an infraction under Indiana Code 9-4-2-1-127, Sec. 1, for any person to violate this ordinance.



