

AN ORDINANCE TO RENAME CERTAIN STREETS  
IN THE COMMUNITY OF FISH LAKE,  
LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE # 93-6

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana is charged with the responsibility of maintenance, supervision and organization of the streets and roads in the rural and unincorporated areas of LaPorte County, and;

WHEREAS, the responsibility of the Commissioners is to see that said streets and roads are designated by names or numbers, and;

WHEREAS, the residents of Hillside Drive and Lincoln Drive in Fish Lake have petitioned the Commissioners to rename said streets, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commissioners to rename Hillside Drive and Lincoln Drive in the community of Fish Lake.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners as follows:

Streets in the vicinity of Fish Lake shall be renamed as follows:


1. A segment of the street currently known as Lincoln Drive that intersects with Hillside Drive shall be renamed Emerick Drive.
2. A segment of the street currently known as Hillside Drive that intersects with 800 E. and running to Lincoln Drive shall be renamed Emerick Drive.

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Highway Department is instructed to erect street signs with the new name designations on the streets following the passage of this ordinance.

WHEREAS, notice of the change in name shall be directed to the United States Postal Service, the Lincoln Township Fire Department, LaPorte County Emergency Medical Services, E-911, and LaPorte County Sheriff's Department.

All of which is ordained and passed this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 1993, by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County.
