

ORDINANCE NO. 93-9
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Indiana Law makes provision for the establishment of county public defender boards, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it advisable that the County of LaPorte establish such a board with all the rights and duties that attend thereto, as per state statute,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA that:

Section 1. The LaPorte County Public Defender Board is hereby established for the purposes of providing legal representation to indigent defendants in criminal, juvenile, probation revocation, extradition, child support, civil commitments and other proceedings where the right to counsel has been established by law.

Section 2. Said LaPorte County Public Defender Board shall be governed by and operated in accordance with the provisions of Indiana Code Section 33-9-15-1 et seq.

Section 3. The reference in Section 2 above to state statute shall mean the statute as amended from time to time, or any similar statutory provision that may supersede it relating to the same or similar subject matter.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval and publication.
