

ORDINANCE NO. 94-7

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING A COUNTY-WIDE FEE FOR THE  
ENHANCED EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, I.C. (36-8-16-7) allows for the change in the amount of the established fee by the County legislative body of a county-wide enhanced emergency telephone system and the imposition of a fee to pay the costs of said system; and

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Council did establish a fee of \$0.66 per month on November 26, 1990.

NOW THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby ordained by the LaPorte County Commission:


**Section 1.** The LaPorte County Commission does hereby increase the established enhanced emergency telephone system fee to the rate of \$0.74 per month. Said fee to be assessed on each exchange access facility in the service area covered by the enhanced emergency system.

**Section 2.** The provisions of I.C. 36-8-16-1 through 19 shall control the operation of the enhanced emergency telephone system and the imposition and collection of the system fee.


**Section 3.** Pursuant to I.C. 36-8-16-9, the fee established by this ordinance shall take effect on the first day of May, 1994.




