

ORDINANCE NO. 94 -21

An Ordinance of the County Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, to supplement Ordinance No. 90-7 which provided for the establishment and collection of fees for services provided by the LaPorte County Health Department.

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners did on September 26, 1994, approve a supplemental schedule of fees to cover an additional range of services provided by the LaPorte County Health Department; and,

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners now wishes to give the proposed fee schedule full force and effect of law; and,

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners wishes to clarify the provisions of such services;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered by the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners as follows:

Section 1.

Section III of Ordinance No. 90-7 is now amended to contain these additional inclusions:

Section III - Fees for Services

Environmental Health Services

a. **Water Samples**

Lead -	\$15.00
Nitrite -	\$10.00
Iron, Total -	\$15.00
Ammonia -	\$10.00
Phosphorus -	\$15.00
Suspended Solids -	\$10.00
Detergents/Surfactants -	\$15.00

Personal Health Care

a. Immunization Administration Fees:

Injection: \$1.00

Oral Polio: \$.50

A maximum of \$2.00 per child, or \$3.00 per family per visit will be charged. No child will be denied service for lack of ability to pay an administration fee.

b. **Blood Profile:** \$10.00

c. **Diabetes Screening Fee:** \$2.00

d. **Mantoux (TB) Screening Test Fee:** \$1.00 - Unless a patron fails to return for reading. Then \$5.00 will be charged if that patron requests a second test. The \$5.00 charge will also be applied, if a parent fails to bring his/her child for a reading as scheduled, but then re-schedules for a second TB test.

e. **Fees for Combined Immunization and TB Services:** \$1.00

f. **Blood Pressure Screening:** No charge.

No one will be refused services because of the lack of ability to pay.

Section 2.

All parts of Ordinance No. 90-7 and any and all other pertinent Ordinances in conflict with Section 1 above are hereby repealed, but those parts of the above ordinances which are not in conflict with Section 1 above are hereby retained.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval and publication.
