AN ORDINANCE VACATING BEECH STREET IN MINERAL SPRINGS-TEE LAKE CLUB, A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 38, NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, GALENA TOWNSHIP, LA PORTE COUNTY, INDIANA. ^{BARBARA L. EULER RECORDER LA PORTE CO.}

WHEREAS, Donald Schleyer and Elizabeth Schleyer, Doris M. Schleyer, Richard Johnson and Delores Johnson, and Richard Johnson and Cindy Johnson have filed their petition to vacate Beech Street in Mineral Springs-Tee Lake Club, a subdivision of part of Section 30, Township 38 North, Range 2 West, Galena Township, La Porte County, Indiana, as recorded in Plat Book 6, at Page 39 in the Office of the Recorder of La Porte County, Indiana, on the 21st day of October, 1994, and hearing on said petition was set for November 7, 1994, at 10:00 a.m.; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing on said petition was published in the La Porte Herald-Argus on October 25, 1994, and in the Michigan City News Dispatch on October 26, 1994; and,

WHEREAS, Herbert C. Sommer and Gerard C. Ahlers, the only persons beside petitioners owning land adjoining said Beech Street have filed waiver of notice of hearing and consent to the granting of the petition; and,

WHEREAS, all persons owning lands adjoining said Beech Street have either joined in the petition or signed a waiver of notice and consent to the granting of same; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice, hearing was conducted by the Board of Commissioners on the 7th day of November, 1994; and,

WHEREAS, no written remonstrances were to the granting of said petition was filed and no persons appeared in person at said hearing to remonstrate; and,

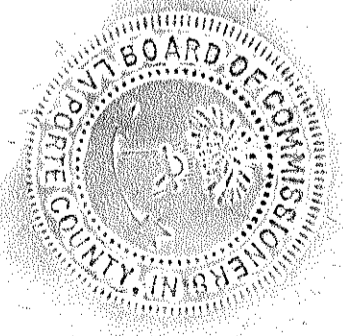
WHEREAS, the Board finds that the petition should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Beech Street, as platted in Mineral Springs-Tee Lake Club, a subdivision of part of Section 30, Township 38 North, Range 2 West, Galena Township, La Porte County, Indiana, as the same appears in Plat Book 6, page 39 in the Office of the Recorder of La Porte County, Indiana, is hereby vacated from its intersection with Schleyer Drive on the North to its southern terminus which coincides with the southerly line extended of Lot 13 in Block "F", of Mineral Springs-Tee Lake Subdivision, La Porte County, Indiana.

2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the time of its passage.
