ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PORTIONS OF SHORE DRIVE IN FISH LAKE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, petitioners, Maureen Lee, Thomas A. Lee, Margaret H. Martin, William D. Fanning, Donna E. Fanning, Vivian Nader, Edward Nader and Claudette Romanoski have filed a Petition for vacation of portions of Shore Drive between the streets of Katherine Drive and Julia Drive located in Southtown Beach Orchard, Addition of Fish Lake, as shown in Plat Book 7, page 133, as recorded in the Office of the Recorder of La Porte County, Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, petitioners are the owners of land which abuts said public way; and,

WHEREAS, the property owners of all adjoining and abutting lots have been served with notice of public hearing pursuant to Indiana statute; and,

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing on the Petition was published in the La Porte Herald-Argus on the 30th day of April, 1996; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the 20th day of May, 1996, in the Chambers of the La Porte County Commissioners, in the La Porte County Courthouse, 813 Lincolnway, La Porte, Indiana, at which hearing all interested parties were given an opportunity to present their views for and against the granting of the petition to vacate; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the adjacent property owners that the petition be granted and the street be vacated; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:


