

LAPORTE COUNTY ORDINANCE 96- 25

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A  
SPECIAL VEHICLE INSPECTION FUND  
AND ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR VEHICLE INSPECTION**

WHEREAS, Section I.C. 9-29-4-2 grants the power to counties to implement a charge for vehicle inspection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believe that it is in the best interests of LaPorte County that such an inspection procedure be implemented and charges to pay the cost thereof be imposed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana:


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County does hereby determine that a need exists for the creation of a vehicle inspection fund to be established and operated pursuant to I.C. 9-29-4-2.

Section 2. That a need exists to establish a fee chargeable by the LaPorte County Sheriff's Department for inspecting a vehicle and making a record of the inspection upon the application form for the issuance of a certificate of title to said vehicle in accordance with I.C. 9-29-4-2 et seq. and that such fee shall be in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00) and shall be deposited in the vehicle inspection fund.


Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, and publication as may be required by law.


