

ORDER OF PROBATION

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you shall comply with the following terms of probation:

1. You shall refrain from violating any law, federal, state or local, and you shall advise the probation department within 1 (one) working day if charged with a Misdemeanor or a Felony.
2. You shall not change residence or employment without first obtaining permission from the Court or an officer of the probation department. You shall notify the probation department of your new address or new employment within 1 (one) working day.
3. Travel outside of Indiana is not permitted unless ordered by the Court. Travel within Indiana, but outside of LaPorte County, is not permitted without permission of the probation department. Verifiable work related travel is an exception to this rule.
4. You shall report for probation appointments as directed by the probation department.
5. You shall not associate with any person of bad character or reputation; gang affiliates; criminals; or with any person likely to influence you to commit any crime.
6. You shall work regularly at a lawful occupation and support your legal dependents, if any, to the best of your ability.
7. You shall not use, purchase, or possess illegal drugs nor will you visit any places where illegal drugs are used, possessed, sold or dispensed unlawfully.
8. You shall not buy, possess, have under your control, or consume any alcoholic beverage. You shall not be in any place where alcoholic beverages are present without prior approval from your probation officer.
9. You shall submit to alcohol or drug testing as requested by the probation department and you shall pay for the testing as directed.
10. You shall answer all reasonable inquiries of the probation department in an honest manner.

11. You shall permit your probation officer or an authorized agent of the probation department to visit you at reasonable times at your home or elsewhere. Furthermore, you shall waive any and all rights as to search and seizure during your period of probation and submit to the search of your person or property by an authorized agent of the probation department if a search is requested by the probation department of this Court.
12. You shall not own nor have in your possession any firearms or dangerous weapons.
13. If your sentence includes community corrections, including but not limited to Work Release or Home Detention, you shall not engage in any conduct that may result in your removal from said program.
14. You shall comply with any recommendations of the Probation Department concerning any counseling and/or treatment deemed necessary. While participating in any counseling/program, you shall comply with all rules of said program.
15. You shall actively pursue the completion of a G.E.D. if applicable.

OTHER CONDITIONS:

If it appears to the Court that you have violated any one (1) of these conditions of your probation, the Court may, after hearing, Order execution of the sentence that was suspended. The filing of said petition may be filed during the probationary period or before the earlier of the following:

1. One (1) year after the termination of probation;
2. Forty-five (45) days after the state receives notice of the violation.
